

**BUILDING & CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY
APPLICATION FOR SERVICE -
FOR A PERIOD OF SPECULATIVE BUILDING WORK**

If you are out of work and you build or renovate a house to sell, then you may be entitled to service credits for the time spent building or renovating the house.

A worker who performed unpaid building and construction work on a residential building, constructed or acquired by the worker solely for the purposes of subsequent sale, is able to apply for service credits for the time spent doing that work.

Solely means for one reason only. Workers who acquire properties and live in them or rent them out while doing improvements as an alternative to doing typical subcontract work, are not eligible for service credits for the time spent doing that work. The use of a property as a residence amounts to a dual purpose and the work is not eligible for service crediting.
