

## HOW DO I STOP THE CANCELLATION OF MY REGISTRATION?

To see if you are eligible to stop cancellation of your registration, check the list below. If you are eligible, an **Appeal Form** will need to be completed and returned by **28 June 2019**.

### GROUNDINGS FOR APPEAL

- You performed building and construction work in NSW.
- You did not perform paid work of any kind since you last worked in the building and construction industry, due to an illness or injury, as certified by a medical practitioner.
- You did not perform paid work of any kind since you last worked in the building and construction industry and were undertaking industry training to help you get back to employment in the industry.
- You performed voluntary building and construction work in NSW as a result of a declared emergency under the *State Emergency and Rescue Management Act 1989*, or under any similar Act of the State or of the Commonwealth.
- You performed light duties in accordance with the *Workers Compensation Act 1987*, while partially incapacitated for work as a result of an injury sustained while performing building and construction work.
- You performed unpaid building and construction work on a residential building owned by you and purchased for resale.

### GROUNDINGS FOR PRESERVATION

- You were credited with service with an interstate building and construction industry long service scheme.
- You were pregnant.
- You received a Commonwealth Carer Payment under the *Social Security Act 1991* of the Commonwealth.
- You were an employee of a government authority, county council or local council, performing building and construction work under an arrangement that did not provide for making payments of long service benefits.

**IF NONE OF THE ABOVE APPLY, THERE IS NOTHING FURTHER TO DO. YOUR REGISTRATION WILL BE CANCELLED ON 30 JUNE 2019.**
